# RHCE/ Red Hat Certified Engineer

The RHCE certificate is designed to fit in a specific place within the computer industry spectrum of UNIX/Linux user levels.

### Job Role

- Set up and manage Linux servers running production network services and security

### Prerequisites

- User-level experience with any computer system, including: use of mouse, use of menus and use of any graphical user interface

### Certificate Courses

#### Red hat Linux Essentials (5 days = 40 hours)

For persons who have no command-line experience in Linux or UNIX and want to develop skills for using and customizing their own Red Hat Linux workstation.

#### Red Hat Linux System Administration (5 days = 40 hours)

For users of Linux (or UNIX) who want to start building skills in systems administration on Red Hat Linux, to a level where they can attach and configure a workstation on an existing network.

#### Red Hat Linux Networking & Security Administration (5 days = 40 hours)

For Linux- and/or UNIX- systems administrators who want to build skills at configuring common network services and security administration using Red Hat Linux.
